

2010-2011 Tuition & Fees

As Easy As 1-2-3

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REQUIRED FEES

New Student Application Fee \$375
(per student, non-refundable)

This fee is due with the completed application. Should the grade level be closed, this fee will hold your student's place on the waiting list. If your student is not accepted, \$200 will be refundable. Application fee includes admission test.

Re-Enrollment Fee \$375
(per student, non-refundable; maximum of \$750 per family)

EARLY BIRD DISCOUNT thru March 5th \$300
(per student, non-refundable; maximum of \$600 per family)

This fee is due in full from returning WCS families along with the completed Re-enrollment form. After March 5th, returning students *lose priority status* and enrollment is on a first come, first served basis as space is available.

3 PAYMENT PLAN OPTION

This fee can be made in 3 payments of \$125 (per student).
-1st payment due with reenrollment forms by March 5th.
-2nd payment due by April 5th.
-3rd payment due by May 5th.

International Student Application Fee

(per student, non-refundable includes WCS' I-20 processing) \$675

This fee is due with the completed application. Should the grade level be closed, this fee will hold your student's place on the waiting list. If your student is not accepted, \$200 will be refundable.

Opportunity Program \$200/mo.
Daily small group instruction for Reading for students with unique learning needs. Includes small group instruction, assessment, and intervention strategies for success.

Tuition Payment Plans

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Students are enrolled and tuition is charged for the full school year (annual fee). The tuition account will include all tuition and applicable fees for the full school year. Several payment plans are offered as a courtesy to help make tuition affordable.

_____ **Single Annual Payment (K-8 only):** A single annual tuition payment will be given a 4% discount, on the tuition only, when the tuition and applicable fees are paid in full on or before Registration Day, July 19, 2010. A 2% discount will be given if paid on or before the first day of school. There are no longer any additional discounts for paying by credit card. (*Note: trip charges, childcare fees, and other miscellaneous fees will be charged as applicable during the school year.*)

_____ **Automatic 12-month Payment Plan:** Monthly payments for all tuition, fees, trips and camps are made by a monthly automatic withdrawal from a single checking or savings account. Forms are available in the school office. Debit from account will be done on the 5th of each month or the next business day if the 5th falls on a weekend. (*WCSP-Homeschool is a 10-payment plan, July-April.*)

_____ **Manual 12-month Payment Plan:** Monthly payments for all tuition, fees, trips and camps are made by a monthly check payment to your account. Tuition is due and payable on the 1st of each month. Tuition is late after the 5th of the month. **Beginning July 1, 2010 all checks for payment will be scanned in our office and deposited as a one-time electronic fund transfer.** (*WCSP-Homeschool is a 10-payment plan, July-April.*)

Financial Aid

Extended Field Trips Are Part of The Curriculum

Third Grade \$90*

Third graders will enjoy an extended learning experience in San Diego, continuing their study of Endangered Species, riding Amtrak round trip. 1 day (1 payment billed in January)

Fourth Grade \$600*

Fourth graders experience California in a grand way, touring Coloma, Sacramento, San Francisco and home. 3 days/2 nights, all inclusive. (5 payments billed July - November)

Fifth Grade \$110*

Fifth graders journey back in CA history and spend a night as a crew member of the brig Pilgrim ship docked in Dana Point. (1 payment billed in January)

Sixth Grade \$340*

Sixth graders take a walk on the wild side at Nature Study Camp, extending their science knowledge and understanding. 5 days/4 nights, all inclusive. (3 payments billed July, August & September)

Seventh Grade \$375*

Seventh graders participate in a hands on science camp experience. 5 days/4 nights, all inclusive. (3 payments billed July, August & September)

Eighth Grade \$1900*

This 12-day study tour is the highlight of a student's time at WCJH and part of an eighth grader's history curriculum. Tour Williamsburg, Jamestown, Richmond, Philadelphia, Washington DC and New York to name a few. 12 days/11 nights, all inclusive. (5 payments billed July - November)

Chaperone fees (same price as student) will be billed in 3 payments (5 payments for 8th grade trip) based on chaperone selection date.

Extended Day Care

Available from 7 a.m. - 6 p.m. 12 months/year. Includes supervision and special summer field trips (Monday and Friday) and activities throughout the week. Separate registration and fees required.

Summer at WCS

Summer School

Kindergarten - Sixth Grade \$250
Summer School is held every Tuesday, Wednesday and Thursday for five weeks. Students focus on math and reading skills, along with a choice of elective activities. Students can still participate in Monday and Friday special field trips with Extended Day Care.

Junior High \$50 per week
Junior highers participate in subject specific focus weeks for summer school.

Sports Camps \$75 per sport

Four sports clinic weeks are held during the summer for boys' basketball and flag football and for girls' basketball and volleyball. Come improve your skills or learn the sport.
